Lower House Farm Waste Recycling Centre and Household Waste Transfer Station

Dear Resident,

Warwickshire County Council Waste and Environment Services have submitted a planning application to develop the old skin farm at lower house Farm on Lower house lane/Gipsy lane/Boulters lane into a household waste recycling centre and a bulk waste transfer station. This station will accept household refuse vehicles from

North Warwickshire

Nuneaton

Bedworth

and Tamworth

every time they need to empty there loads of household waste rubbish. This will then be reloaded onto 55 foot Lorries and transported to an incinerator for disposal . **A total of 360 tons per day.**

The site will open at **7am** each day and close at **10pm** each night with all the potential noise and traffic chaos this will inevitably create. It will operate **7 days** a week.

The proposed site is located on a “C” road, yes a country lane. It is on the top of a hill with bends each side of the site. All traffic to the site will travel via the A5 ??? **Or the villages roads and cut through runs.** All traffic leaving the site will have to go to Dordon Island. Local business’s will be able to take their waste there which means lorries and vans etc as well as up to **800 to a 1000** cars each day plus **80** council and waste transfer **55 foot** vehicles all on the country lane and all going to Dordon Island.

We as an organisation have taken the lead in investigating the background to the application and the potential problems it will bring to our villages and homes. Attached to this letter is a list of the credible and acceptable reasons to object to the application. This can be attached to your personal letter.

Please act now to show your objection to this inappropriate proposal it will affect all of the villages in the area.

You must take the time to write a letter or to email a letter to the planning officer handling the application who’s details are shown below.
